

# **Stamford Community Action Day**

#### Stamford Station Lincolnshire



Replacing the life expired steel supports in the tunnel

### **Project Objectives**

With permission from Network Rail and the station adopters, AmcoGiffen set up a site compound using a section of the car park for the duration of the scheme.

The tunnel strengthening work and removal of the compound was completed in the dead of winter so the team agreed to return in spring to return the area back as was. Instead, AmcoGiffen, East Midlands Rail, Network Rail and a group of volunteers from the station adopters came together to create a new garden area.

## **Action day activity** work included:

- Around 18 people working together
- De-vegetation of embankment and garden area
- Clearance and litter removal
- Rotavated and turned over area for planting
- Upcycled timber from a scheme nearby to make box planters
- Welfare van and refreshments provided by AmcoGiffen
- Pallets donated by AmcoGiffen for the new compost bin
- East Midlands Rail donated sleepers to create safety barrier from parking
- AmcoGiffen also donated £200 for the adopters to fill the garden in the coming weeks
